# MINUTES LBHA Board of Directors Meeting August 26, 2020

The Board of Directors held a meeting at the arena in Loomis. The following Board members were present: Liz Daffner, Maureen Henderson, Janis Rau, Greg King, Joe Warlow, and Bruce Renfrew.Laurene Davis, Activity Chair was also present. Melanie Warlow, Kate Johnson, and Kathy Dombrowski were not present.

Liz Daffner presided. The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m.

Liz reviewed the agenda for the meeting, the focus being the upcoming horse shows.

The obstacle day scheduled for August 21 was cancelled due to heavy smoke. After discussion, a new date of Friday, September 11 was scheduled. Set up will be at 5:00 pm with the event beginning at 5:30 pm.

There was discussion about removing the pre-entry fee of \$4.50 from the shows and just having one flat fee of \$4.95 per class. After discussion, it was unanimously decided to do away with the pre-entry fee.

Liz went over the forms she had put together to help organize the show. She reviewed the new electronic entry form she had created and discussed paying electronically for classes. She discussed adding Covid 19 language to our online form which includes non-liability disclosures for entries. We further discussed obtaining Social Distancing Posters from Placer County. Maureen and Janis will be responsible for providing a hand washing station by the Porta Potty.

Maureen will re-create the Sponsorship form so appropriate changes can be made. Liz will be responsible for designing the Ranch Riding Pattern.




#### **Arena**

Please NO TRAILERS or HORSES on the asphalt parking lot. No barrels, poles or other equipment may be used in the arena. Small Orange cones allowed. Trainers must have an Arena Use form submitted annually as well as the proper insurance naming LBHA and Placer County as "Also Insureds." If Insurance is cancelled 2 times or more, the permit is no longer valid. Trainers MUST contact LBHA with the time and number of students that will be in class, 24 hrs before the lesson.
