MINUTES LBHA Board Meeting April 8, 2019

Page 3

The Board held a meeting at Round Table Pizza located on Horseshoe Bar Road, Loomis, CA. The following Board members were present: Liz Daffner, Maureen Henderson, Greg King, Joe Warlow, Janis Rau, Denise Howell, and Kathy Dombrowski. Kate Johnson and Bruce Renfrow were unable to be present.

Maureen submitted an update on the Placer County Park, Trail and Open Space Master Plan. Hidden Falls Expansion is included in the Master Plan. Because there is a new Board, Maureen wanted to clarify the position previously taken by the organization with regard to the Hidden Falls Expansion. There are a few members who live in the area of the proposed expansion of Hidden Falls. Some of these members attend the public hearings and have spoken in opposition to the proposed expansion.

Maureen and Janis attended the Penryn/Loomis MAC meeting held on March 26 at the Blue Goose Event Center in Loomis. Due to the public comments made by a couple of our members, neither Maureen or Janis spoke up on behalf of LBHA. Discussion ensued about the position LBHA will take at future public meetings. Liz made a motion that LBHA continue to stand behind the support it has previously shown in favor of Hidden Falls and the expansion. The motion was seconded by Joe (? Not sure who seconded the motion). After further discussion, the motion was voted on and unanimously approved. An email blast will be sent to our members to encourage them to attend the future MAC hearings which will be held from now until the end of May. Maureen will prepare the email.

The next agenda item concerned the parking at Loomis Park. The Parks Dept. would like to utilize some of the horse area for parking. Janis made a motion that we work with the Parks Dept. to make more parking room with the stipulation that we would try it for one year. The motion was seconded by Greg. After discussion, the motion was unanimously approved.

Liz informed the Board that Andy Fisher of Placer County Parks has asked to speak to us about the status of the Hidden Falls Expansion. Though meetings are already booked through June, we will ask the May speaker to move to July and invite Andy to attend the May 15 general membership meeting. Kathy offered to call Andy to confirm his availability on that date.

Member Betty Estep approached Liz about a cow clinic on May 11 at the Bar 7s Arena. Liz will follow up in organizing this cow clinic.

Trainers must have an Arena Use form submitted annually as well as the proper insurance naming LBHA and Placer County as "Also Insureds." If Insurance is cancelled 2 times or more, the permit is no longer valid. Trainers MUST contact LBHA with the time and number of students that will be in class, 24 hrs before the lesson.
